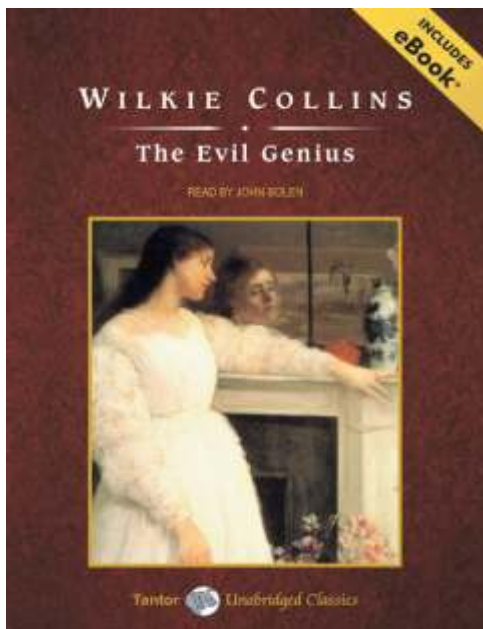

Wilkie Collins (1824–1889) was an English novelist who critics often credit with the invention of the English detective novel. Sergeant Cuff from Collins's novel *The Moonstone* became a prototype of the detective hero in English fiction. His works

center on mainstream Victorian domestic life. He liked to tackle social issues, and many of his novels contain sympathetic portraits of physically abnormal individuals. In addition to *The Moonstone*, he is well known for *Woman in White*, *No Name*, and *Armada*.

John Bolen brings his extensive theater, film, and TV experience to audiobooks. Recent TV appearances include *CIA: Masters of Deception* on the Discovery Channel. Bolen's many audiobook titles include *The Call of the Canyon* by Zane Grey and *Mutiny of the Elsinore* by Jack London.
